- WHEREAS:** The Clayton County Parks and Recreation Department has been awarded a Transportation Enhancement (TE) Grant from the Georgia Department of Transportation for Jesters Creek Trail; and
- WHEREAS:** The grant funds will improve pedestrian access from the Shelnett Inter-Generational Center to the Jesters Creek Trail head as well as construction of an outdoor meeting space adjacent to the Headquarters Library for public use; and
- WHEREAS:** The Transportation Enhancement Grant will provide new and interpretive signage along the trail, installation of four solar powered emergency call boxes, and selectively clear vegetation to increase sight distances for improved safety and awareness; and
