Introducing the Clayton County Youth Commission

BACKGROUND

The Clayton County Board of Commissioners recognized that youth perspective on issues pertaining to the youth in Clayton County is an important part of decision making and there is value in having a mechanism for youth to have a voice in County affairs and issues relating to youth, while at the same time providing an opportunity for them to become contributing members of Clayton County. Therefore, at its March 3, 2015 meeting, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners voted to establish the **Clayton County Youth Commission** by passing Resolution 2015-69.

STRUCTURE

The Commission will be constructed of nine (9) youths from the County between the ages of 14 and 18. Each member of the Board of Commissioners will select two (2) youths and the Chairman will select one youth. The Board of Commissioners will appoint advisors that will consist of County staff and citizens. The Chairman and each member of the Board of Commissioners will choose one (1) advisor, who will be subject to a background check, to assist the Youth Commission as needed or requested by that Commission. The Board of Commissioners will also select County staff with a background in working with youth to assist the Youth Commission.

TIMELINE FOR ESTABLISHING THE YOUTH COMMISSION

Following is the proposed timeline for next steps in the establishment of the Clayton County Youth Commission.

- April:** Board of Commissioners make their appointments of the youths to serve on The Youth Commission, as well as appoint their Advisor.
- May:** An introductory meeting of the Youth Commission will be held to discuss framework of the Youth Commission.
- August:** The first official organizing meeting of the Youth Commission to be held.

MARTA On the Go App

Description

This mobile app is currently developed for the iPhone, and Android devices. It provides scheduling information for bus and rail services. The app will also provide real-time bus and rail information, service alerts, and connecting bus route(s) information.

MARTA Information as shared at the First Saturday Talk on March 7, 2015

The results of the countywide Job Fairs:

- 31 Clayton County residents have been hired by MARTA through all of the combined Job Fairs hosted throughout the county.
- 63 Total positions through the Clayton County expansion are expected to be filled this year as the additional phases roll out.
- MARTA says that they currently have 200 open positions and are actively seeking qualified applicants.

Police/Public Safety:

- 13 officers are dedicated to Clayton County. 2 of the officers will be Sergeants.
- All buses will have an officer on the bus. The officers only have jurisdiction on the bus, they do not police bus stops.
- There will be a MARTA police precinct in Clayton County. They are looking for a location now, but may share space right now.

Breeze Card:

- Costs \$1 (card itself) expected to rise to \$2 by the summer. Breeze card is loaded with money.
- Each MARTA ride costs \$2.50. You can load 10 rides for \$25 or 20 rides for \$42.50.
- You can choose unlimited ride options, 7 day pass is \$23.75 and an unlimited 30 day pass is \$95.
- A one day unlimited pass is \$9, two day pass is \$14, 3 day pass is \$16 and a 4 day pass is \$19.
- It is recommended to register the Breeze Card online which allows for any money to be returned if the card is lost, stolen or destroyed.

MARTA MOBILITY

Frequently Asked Questions

What is MARTA Mobility?

MARTA Mobility is an advanced reservation service that provides **ADA Complementary Paratransit Transportation** to eligible persons with disabilities who are, unable to board, ride or disembark from a MARTA regular bus or train. MARTA Mobility on a curb-to-curb, shared ride basis.

Who Qualifies for MARTA Mobility?

Individuals having mobility limitations may be eligible for MARTA Mobility on a temporary or permanent basis. Call MARTA's Eligibility and Certification office at (404) 848-5389 for information about MARTA Mobility services or to request an ADA Eligibility Application. For specific Customer Service inquiries regarding MARTA Mobility, please call (404) 848-5389 or 711 (Georgia Relay for Hearing Impaired).

How long will it take to determine eligibility?

MARTA processes a completed application within 21 calendar days of receipt. An application is complete when the applicant's Part A is matched with the Health Care Professional's Part B. Customers will be notified in writing, or alternative formats if requested, about their eligibility.

What is the Fare for MARTA Mobility?

The one-way fare is \$4.00 per person. MARTA Mobility Customers who require a Personal Care Attendant must advise may travel with the MARTA Mobility customer for free. Companions may also ride; however, they are required to pay the full fare. In accordance with MARTA policy, two children under 46' may ride free with a Mobility customer.

What are the days and hours of Operation?

The service is offered on the same days and hours as the regular bus and rail service. Generally, service hours are from 5:00 AM to 12:30 AM, seven days a week including holidays. However, when a fixed route in a particular area operates on a more limited basis, MARTA Mobility will operate comparable days and hours.

What is the service area?

Service is restricted to the ADA designated service area within Fulton, DeKalb, and Clayton Counties along a 3/4 of a mile corridor located on each side of all fixed bus routes and in 3/4 of a mile radius of each station.



Clayton County Meals On Wheels Program Participates In Annual

March For Meals Awareness Campaign

Community support will help to address senior hunger and isolation

Clayton County Senior Services Meals On Wheels (MOW) Program once again participated in the March For Meals campaign. March For Meals is a national campaign held during the month of March and is initiated and sponsored by the Meals On Wheels Association of America, to raise awareness of senior hunger and isolation. Additionally the annual campaign encourages action on the part of local communities to support the lifesaving, quality of life program.

To officially launch the 2015 March For Meals campaign in Clayton County a proclamation was presented by Chairman Jeffrey Turner during the Board of Commissioners March 3rd Business Meeting declaring the month “March For Meals Month” in Clayton County and saluted the many Meals On Wheels volunteers and community advocates. During the week of March 16-20, Community Champions’ Week, the Chairman, County Commissioners, public safety officials from the Fire and Emergency Response department, the Sheriff’s Office, Clayton County Police Department, and community advocates partnered with Meals On Wheels drivers to drop off nutritious meals to seniors throughout the county. Additionally, along with long-time MOW supporter Mayor Willie Oswalt, other Clayton County mayors joined fellow mayors nationwide as they took time out of their busy schedules to deliver a delicious meal to a homebound resident within their community as part of Community Champions’ Week. To wrap up the month long awareness campaign the week of March 23 – 27 is Senior Services Week. Personnel throughout the department had the opportunity to get out into the community and deliver meals to homebound seniors throughout Clayton County.

In 2014 Clayton County Meals On Wheels program provided 2648 nutritious meals per month and 31,780 meals per year to seniors throughout the county. Not only do these meals allow many of the county’s older residents to remain independent in their homes for years but they also serve as a social outlet for clients that may not have anyone else to talk to other than the person that delivers their meal.






