ORDINANCE NUMBER 2007 - 14

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 50 HEALTH AND SANITATION, ARTICLE I, IN GENERAL, SECTION 50-2 "BOARD OF HEALTH REGULATIONS" SO AS TO AMEND THE PRESENT ENUMERATED DEFINITION OF BOARD OF HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS ACCEPTED AND APPROVED FOR ENFORCEMENT SO AS TO AMEND SUBSECTION (1) SO AS TO REFLECT THE CURRENT CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, ON-SITE SEWAGE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS RULES AND REGULATIONS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting from Chapter 50, Health and Sanitation, Article I, In General, Section 50-2 "Board of health regulations," subsection (1) of subsection (b), in its entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

"(1) A booklet entitled 'Clayton County Board of Health, On-site Sewage Management Systems Rules and Regulations,' which includes the Rules of Department of Human Resources, Public Health Chapter 290-5-26, "On-site Sewage Management Systems," pages A1-19, dated June 27, 2005, and Attachment A, "Minimum Lot Size Requirements in Clayton County"."


Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
