RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 156

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A DOG CONTROL OFFICER WHO WILL EXERCISE THE POWERS ASSIGNED UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE DANGEROUS DOG ACT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 14-137 of the Clayton County of Ordinances provides that the Board of Commissioners shall designate a dog control officer who shall perform the duties and exercise the powers assigned to that position by the Dangerous Dog Act; and

WHEREAS, Chief Jeffrey E. Turner has recommended Lieutenant Garland L. Watkins be designated as the dog control officer; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by designating a dog control officer for the above stated purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby designates Lieutenant Garland L. Watkins as the dog control officer of Clayton County. Such officer shall exercise the powers assigned under provisions of the Dangerous Dog Act and perform such other duties and functions authorized by State law and the Code of Clayton County, Georgia.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




