RESOLUTION NO. 2008 – 23

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SUPPORT OF STATE LOCAL LEGISLATION RENAMING A PORTION OF GEORGIA HIGHWAY 138 AS LAKE SPIVEY PARKWAY TO BE INTRODUCED IN THE 2008 GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY MEMBERS OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, members of the 2006 Clayton County Legislative delegation introduced House Resolution 1609 dedicating a portion of Georgia Highway 138 as Lake Spivey Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wish to communicate their support for renaming that portion of Georgia Highway 138 extending from Interstate 675 to the city limits of Jonesboro, to Lake Spivey Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners would like for that portion of public right-of-way dedicated as the Charles “Ed” Holcomb Highway, extending from McDonough Street to the Henry County line, to remain as previously dedicated and any signage language to honor his memory be placed along side the name of Lake Spivey Parkway;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County to support the introduction of such legislation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby supports the introduction of legislation by the Clayton County Legislative Delegation in the 2008 Session of the General Assembly renaming that portion of Georgia Highway 138 extending from Interstate 675 to the city limits of Jonesboro, to Lake

Spivey Parkway, and to continue to honor Mr. Charles "Ed" Holcomb with that portion of public right-of-way previously dedicated as the Charles "Ed" Holcomb Highway which extends from McDonough Street to the Henry County line with signage language honoring his memory placed along side the name of Lake Spivey Parkway.

Section 2. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to send a copy of this Resolution to the Chairperson and members of the Clayton County Delegation.


Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




