RESOLUTION NO. 2008 - 29

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE IN THE NAME OF A PORTION OF THE PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY OF VILLAGE CROSSING CIRCLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE VILLAGES OF ELLENWOOD PHASE A ONE TO VILLAGE CROSSING LANE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS, AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and well being, the Board of Commissioners proposes to rename the north bond section of Village Crossing Circle, continuing to the cul-de-sac of the future phase of the development, to Village Crossing Lane.

WHEREAS, the south bond section of Village Crossing Circle will remain the same.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by renaming a portion of the public road right-of-way of Village Crossing Circle in the development of The Villages of Ellenwood Phase A One to Village Crossing Lane in Clayton County, Georgia.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to rename the north bond section of Village Crossing Circle, continuing to the cul-de-sac of the future phase of the development of the Villages of Ellenwood Phase A One, to Village


Crossing Lane. The south bond section of Village Crossing Circle will remain the same. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all required documents, and otherwise to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Clayton County Transportation & Development Department is hereby requested to notify all those property owners located on the affected road right-of-ways of the change in street names, and to ask that all interested County Departments take appropriate action to amend the maps, signs, and records of Clayton County to reflect this name change.


Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




