RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 108

A RESOLUTION TO DEDICATE A PORTION OF MOUNT ZION BOULEVARD IN HONOR OF MITCH YOUNG; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT TO ERECT SIGNS ON THE DESIGNATED RIGHT OF WAY THAT REFLECT THE DEDICATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Mitchell Wayne Young, a graduate of Jonesboro High School and Master Sergeant in the United States Army, joined Operation Enduring Freedom, was deployed with the Combined Special Forces Task Force and assigned to Company B, 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 7<sup>th</sup> Special Forces Group (Airborne) in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, SFC Mitch Young endured the ultimate sacrifice to his country while in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, a grateful Clayton County government wishes to dedicate a portion of public right-of-way along Mount Zion Boulevard in honor of SFC Mitch Young;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires that the portion of public right-of-way dedicated in honor of SFC Mitch Young extend on Mount Zion Boulevard from the intersections of Wright Circle to Battlecreek Road, and remain indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County to dedicate a portion of public right-of-way on Mount Zion Boulevard to honor SFC Mitch Young.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the dedication of that portion of Mount Zion Boulevard extending from the intersections of Wright Circle to Battlecreek Road in



Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






