RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 162

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT FUNDS AND LEASE A VEHICLE TO BE USED BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN CONNECTION WITH ITS PARTICIPATION WITH THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO ADD THE VEHICLE TO THE COUNTY'S INVENTORY FLEET; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Sheriff's Office ("CCSO") is a member of the Atlanta Drug Enforcement Administration ("DEA") Task force; and

WHEREAS, DEA and the CCSO have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding which provides for among other things, that the CCSO will provide a Deputy for a period of two years to staff the task force and DEA has agreed to provide funds for a vehicle to be leased by the CCSO /County, for use by the Sheriff's Office in connection with its participation with the DEA Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by accepting the funds from the United States Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration for the above-stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept funds from the United States Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration to be used to lease a vehicle to be used by the Sheriff's Office in connection with its participation in the DEA Task Force and authorizes the lease of such vehicle. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman or his designee

to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Central Services to add the vehicle to the County's inventory fleet.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




