RESOLUTION NO. 2009 - 215

A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 2009-202 WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE DELEGATION TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THE POWER AND AUTHORITY TO OVERSEE THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has original and exclusive jurisdiction to make rules and regulations for the county police under O.C.G.A. § 36-5-22.1(a)(8); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is authorized under O.C.G.A. § 36-5-22.1(b) to delegate said authority to the Chairman; and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners has stated that it is his belief that the County Police department should continue to report to the Chief of Staff and that his many years of experience in the supervision, oversight, management, and operation of police departments in major metropolitan areas can best be used by continuing to share that experience with the Chief of Staff; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems and finds it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Clayton County to rescind the delegation to supervise and oversee the management and operations of the Clayton County Police Department, given to the Chairman.

AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby rescinds Resolution 2009-202.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






