RESOLUTION NO. 2009 – 41

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING LOCAL LEGISLATION TO NAME A PORTION OF GEORGIA HIGHWAY 138 AS LAKE SPIVEY PARKWAY TO BE INTRODUCED IN THE 2009 GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY MEMBERS OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Legislative Delegation honored Charles “Ed” Holcomb in the 1998 General Assembly for his notable service to community and country; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly has further honored Mr. Holcomb by dedicating a portion of right-of-way along Georgia Highway 138 as the Charles “Ed” Holcomb Highway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires that the portion of public right-of-way dedicated as the Charles “Ed” Holcomb Highway, extending from McDonough Street to the Henry County line, to remain; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wish to communicate their support for naming that portion of Georgia Highway 138 extending from Interstate 675 to the city limits of Jonesboro, to Lake Spivey Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the wife and three daughters of Mr. Charles “Ed” Holcomb support the naming of Highway 138 to Lake Spivey Parkway while continuing to recognize the memory of their husband and father; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County to support the introduction of such legislation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby supports the introduction of legislation by the Clayton County Legislative Delegation in the 2009 Session of the General Assembly for the purpose of naming that portion of Georgia Highway 138 extending from Interstate 675 to the city limits of Jonesboro, to Lake Spivey Parkway, and to continue to honor Mr. Charles "Ed" Holcomb with that portion of public right-of-way previously dedicated as the Charles "Ed" Holcomb Highway.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




