RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 178

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FURLOUGH DAYS WHICH SHALL BE DECLARED AS PUBLIC AND LEGAL HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CLAYTON COUNTY DURING THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2010 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2011; TO REQUEST THAT ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS OF CLAYTON COUNTY OBSERVE SUCH LEGAL HOLIDAYS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners has received a recommendation of specified calendar furlough days for county employees pertaining to normal business hours; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to approve the furlough days and declare such days as public and legal holidays within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County has studied the proposed calendar days with the approval and consent of the constitutionally elected county officials and considers it in the best interest of the County to adopt them as public and legal holidays.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. In accordance with section 2.5 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances the following dates are hereby to be observed as legal holidays for all offices and departments under the jurisdiction of the Clayton County Board of Commissioners during the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011:

Friday, September 3, 2010 (in conjunction w/Labor Day)

Thursday, December 30, 2010 (in conjunction w/New Year's Day)

Friday, April 22, 2011

Friday, May 27, 2011 (in conjunction w/ Memorial Day)

Section 2. The Elected Officials of Clayton County are hereby requested to observe the above furlough dates as the legal holidays by each employee as prescribed for their respective offices during the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.


Section 3. Amendments to the furlough days as official holidays may be approved by the Board of Commissioners, so as to adapt to changing governmental needs during the current fiscal year and may be made in accordance with the provisions of O.C.G.A. § 36-1-12.

Section 4. All resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

SO RESOLVED, this the 17th day of August, 2010.


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
