A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO SHOW ITS SUPPORT OF CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS DURING “RED RIBBON WEEK”; TO AUTHORIZE A WAIVER OF APPLICATION FEES AND SPECIAL EVENT FEES FOR ALL ACTIVITIES DURING THIS PERIOD; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Public Schools has designated the week of October 23<sup>rd</sup> through October 31<sup>st</sup> as Red Ribbon Week; and

WHEREAS, Red Ribbon Week is a time to bring attention to the ongoing fight against drugs in our community; and

WHEREAS, several Clayton County schools will conduct “I Am Drug Free” activities during Red Ribbon Week including parades and other activities that may require the assistance of the Clayton County Police Department and Clayton County Fire & EMS; and

WHEREAS, to show its support of Red Ribbon Week the Board of Commissioners waives its application fees and special event fees for all activities sponsored by Clayton County Public Schools during Red Ribbon Week; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by waiving said fees for the above-stated purpose.

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners recognizes and supports Clayton County Public Schools during Red Ribbon Week and authorizes Clayton County to waive its

SO RESOLVED, this the 21<sup>st</sup> day of September, 2010.




