RESOLUTION NO. 2010 – 21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A FORFEITED VEHICLE FROM CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATIONS; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE SALE OF SAID VEHICLE AS SURPLUS ITEMS; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department seized a 1995 Chevrolet Caprice in a criminal investigations conducted by the Police Department Uniform Division and the Drug/Gang Violence Task Force, case number J0906282; and

WHEREAS, this vehicle is not acceptable to be put in service as a County vehicle and it is advisable to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicle sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by disposing of the unserviceable vehicle in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to dispose of the unserviceable vehicle described above. The sale of the vehicle will be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Section 2-147 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. Proceeds of the


sale shall be tendered to the County and distributed as provided by State law and any Court Order.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




