ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 54

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART II, CHAPTER 22 "BUSINESSES", ARTICLE V "PAWNBROKERS, DEALERS IN PRECIOUS METALS AND GEMS AND FLEA MARKET OPERATORS", DIVISION 2 "LICENSE", BY DELETING SECTION 22-201 "REQUIRED", AND SUBSTITUTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 22-201 "REQUIRED"; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED:

Section 1. The CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, Part II, Chapter 22 "Businesses", Article V "Pawnbrokers, Dealers In Precious Metals and Gems and Flea Market Operators", Division 2 "License", By Deleting Section 22-201 "Required", and substituting in lieu thereof a new Section 22-201 "License Required" which shall read as follows:

"Sec. 22-201. License Required.

Every person doing business in any unincorporated area of the county as a pawnbroker, dealer in precious metals or gems, itinerant dealer, flea market vendor or flea market operator, prior to commencing business, shall make proper application for and receive the appropriate business license."

Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3 If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the

valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


