RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 76

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO APPLY FOR AND TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS AWARDED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE JUSTICE AND MENTAL HEALTH COLLABORATIVE PROGRAM PLANNING GRANT (the "BJA") ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY PROBATE COURT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES RELATING THERETO, AND TO TRANSFER ANY REQUIRED MATCH OF LOCAL FUNDS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Probate Court (the "Court") desires to apply for the BJA grant for the benefit of the development of the Clayton County Mental Health Court in the amount of \$50,000.00, with a local match by Clayton County, (the "County") in the amount of \$12,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by applying for and accepting grant funds as described herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of the Clayton County Probate Court, to apply for and accept grant funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 awarded by the BJA, with a local match from the County in the amount of \$12,500.00, to benefit the development of the Clayton County Mental Health Court. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute all documents necessary, and to otherwise perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of the Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect appropriations and expenditures relating thereto, and to transfer any required match of local funds.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




