RESOLUTION NO. 2010 - 77

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO COLLABORATE WITH KEEP CLAYTON COUNTY BEAUTIFUL, INC., ATLANTA RECYCLING SOLUTIONS, LLC AND SHRED DOCTOR LLC, AND TO SPONSOR THE "AMERICAN RECYCLES DAY" EVENT AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY RECYCLING DROP OFF CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County has traditionally supported the work of various non-profit organizations, governmental agencies, and professional service providers located and conducting business in Clayton County for the benefit of the County's citizens; and

WHEREAS, in collaboration with Atlanta Recycling Solutions, LLC and Shred Doctor LLC, the Director of Keep Clayton County Beautiful, Inc., in conjunction with the Clayton County Department of Transportation and Development, desires to sponsor on April 3, 2010 the "America Recycles Day" event to take place at the Clayton County Recycling Drop Off Center to provide citizens an opportunity to rid themselves of electronic devices and confidential documents in a safe and proper manner; and

WHEREAS, Keep Clayton County Beautiful, Inc. and the Clayton County Department of Transportation and Development will organize, promote and manage the "America Recycles Day" event; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by collaborating with Keep Clayton County Beautiful, Inc., Atlanta Recycling Solutions, LLC and Shred Doctor LLC to sponsor this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County, through its Department of Transportation and Development and in conjunction with Keep Clayton County Beautiful, Inc., to collaborate with Atlanta Recycling Solutions, LLC and Shred Doctor LLC to sponsor the "America Recycles Day" event which will occur on April 3, 2010 at the Clayton County Recycling Drop Off Center to provide citizens an opportunity to rid themselves of electronic devices and confidential documents in a safe and proper manner.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform any acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.




