RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 05

A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE YEARS OF SERVICE OF POLICE CANINE CHAZ, TO GRANT A CONDITIONAL GIFT FOR HIS REMAINING YEARS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR HIS RETIREMENT FROM ACTIVE SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the County desires to recognize the nine years of faithful service of police canine Chaz; and

WHEREAS, the County commends and acknowledges his assistance in the seizure of 3,573 pounds of marijuana, 920 pounds of cocaine and 46 pounds of other illegal substances, and the seizure of \$2,739,742.00 in drug money; and

WHEREAS, Chaz, now ten years old, is showing the signs of age. His partner has been promoted and Dr. Donald McMillian, Jr. DVM, has examined Chaz and determined that the advanced age of Chaz could lead to separation anxiety and behavioral issues if Chaz was placed with a new handler. Dr. McMillian recommends that Chaz be retired and placed with his human partner, Sergeant Arroyo for his remaining years; and

WHEREAS Sergeant Eric Arroyo has been Chaz's human partner for the past nine years and wishes to provide for Chaz in his retirement and for his remaining years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA
AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

Section 1. The County formally recognizes and commends Sergeant Eric Arroyo and his canine partner, Chaz, for their nine years of outstanding service to the community.

Section 2. The Chairman is authorized to enter into a contract to provide for a conditional gift of canine Chaz to Eric O. Arroyo. Where Eric O. Arroyo is to have and

to hold Chaz for the remainder of Chaz's life, on the condition that Chaz shall not be sold, loaned, given to another, or used as a police canine; and on the further condition that should Eric O. Arroyo be no longer able or willing to provide for Chaz or should there be a default of the stated condition, that Chaz shall be returned to the County's Animal Control Unit.


Section 3. Police canine Chaz is hereby retired from active service with the Clayton County Police Department.

SO RESOLVED, this the 4th day of January, 2011.


