RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 111

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF AN UNSERVICEABLE 1995 FL80 FIRE ENGINE FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO BE DONATED TO THE TOWN OF OCONEE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT; TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM THE TOWN OF OCONEE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT OF A 1975 SEAGRAVE CUSTOM PUMPER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO ACCEPT THE DONATION ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE DISPOSITION OF THE 1995 FIRE ENGINE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Fire and Emergency Services Department has a 1995 FL80 Fire Engine and wishes to donate it to the Town of Oconee Volunteer Fire Department in exchange for a fully restored 1975 Seagrave Custom Pumper of historical value to Clayton County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the 1995 FL80 Fire Engine is not acceptable to be put in service as a County fire and emergency vehicle and it is advisable to dispose of the vehicle ("unserviceable vehicle"); and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicle sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used to benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the unserviceable vehicle by donating it to the

Town of Oconee Volunteer Fire Department with applicable County Ordinance in exchange for a fully restored 1975 Seagrave Custom Pumper of historical value to Clayton County, Georgia

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to dispose of an unserviceable 1995 FL80 Fire Engine by donating it to the Town of Oconee Volunteer Fire Department and to accept in exchange a 1975 Seagrave Custom Pumper of historical value to Clayton County from the Town of Oconee Volunteer Fire Department. The exchange of donations will be handled in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to execute all documents necessary and to perform all acts necessary to effect the resolution. The Directors of Central Service and Finance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




