RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 137

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AND AUTOMATIC AID RESPONSE AGREEMENT WITH FAYETTE COUNTY, GEORGIA PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH SUPPLEMENTAL FIRE SUPPRESSION AND PROTECTION WILL BE RENDERED TO THE OTHER, AND FOR JOINT TRAINING EXERCISES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the laws of Georgia authorize local governments to provide mutual aid; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into a Mutual Aid and Automatic Aid Response Agreement (the "Agreement") to provide supplemental fire suppression, protection, rescue and emergency medical services to the other and to participate in joint training exercises, subject to the limitations set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into the Agreement for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Mutual Aid and Automatic Aid Response Agreement with Fayette County, Georgia to render supplemental fire suppression, protection,

rescue and emergency medical services and to participate in joint training exercises, subject to the limitations set forth in the Agreement.


