RESOLUTION 2011 – 192

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WORKTRAIN STAFFING, LLC, PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH EMPLOYMENT STAFFING SERVICES WILL BE PROVIDED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PROVIDE FOR IN THE BUDGET AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, WorkTrain Staffing, LLC (“WorkTrain”) specializes in the management of employment services for organizations that have a need for transitional workers and has demonstrated exceptional qualifications, responsiveness and cost effectiveness in assisting organizations with employment services; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County recognizes the need of a reputable temporary staffing agency capable of providing a comprehensive catalog of personnel to fill unclassified positions on an as needed, nonpermanent basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interests of Clayton County and the County will be best served by entering into an Agreement with WorkTrain for the reasons contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to enter into an Agreement with WorkTrain Staffing, LLC. The Agreement is attached as “Exhibit

A". The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to provide for an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement. The Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




