RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF JONESBORO PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH A MEDIAN AT THE INTERSECTION OF JONESBORO ROAD AND JOHNSON STREET WILL BE CONSTRUCTED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Jonesboro each desire to collaborate on the construction of a raised concrete median at the intersection of Jonesboro Road and Johnson Street, replacing the existing smaller concrete island as well as the large raised pavement markers whose purpose is to restrict access and vehicle lane changing along a portion of Jonesboro Road, which project cost estimate is \$15,003.00; and

WHEREAS, the County's responsibilities for this project include coordinating any construction related activities, performing all construction work, and utility adjustments and relocations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro is responsible for 100 percent of the project costs which include materials and labor; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Jonesboro to perform the aforementioned project, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Jonesboro to construct a raised concrete median as contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Jonesboro providing for the terms and conditions under which a raised concrete median at the intersection of Jonesboro Road and Johnson Street shall be constructed, replacing the existing smaller concrete island as well as the large raised pavement markers whose purpose is to restrict access and vehicle lane changing along a portion of Jonesboro Road, which project cost estimate is \$15,003.00. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Agreement. The Intergovernmental Agreement shall be subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the Board of Commissioners may approve.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






