RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 61

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW THE INTERNATIONAL CAMPAIGN FOR VICTORY OVER VIOLENCE, INC. TO HOST ITS ANNUAL "VICTORY OVER VIOLENCE" CELEBRATION AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, The International Campaign For Victory Over Violence, Inc. (the "Promoter") wishes to rent the St. Barts Pavilion and Upper Field Area at Clayton County International Park (the "Location") to host its annual "Victory Over Violence" celebration, consisting of a parade at the Location exclusively, led by a Clayton County Public School marching band, as well as speakers, food, music, arts and crafts, a deejay, promotional vendors, free food vendors and children's activities; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter wishes to utilize the Location on May 14, 2011 from approximately 11:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M., with the purpose of promoting community involvement by providing citizens a place to be entertained in a family-friendly atmosphere; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter is qualified to organize and facilitate projects that contribute positively to the community's morale and promote community involvement by offering positive, family-friendly cultural and musical entertainment; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Promoter to host this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF


CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. 
