RESOLUTION NO. 2011 - 62

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A UNITED STATES FLAG FROM LADIES AUXILIARY – VETERANS OF FOREIGN WAR, POST 5080, INC. TO BE ERECTED AT THE MORROW/LAKE CITY PARK IN CLAYTON COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County, on behalf of its Parks and Recreation Department, desires to accept a United States flag from Ladies Auxiliary – Veterans of Foreign War, Post 5080, Inc. (“Donor”) to be erected at the Morrow/Lake City Park; and

WHEREAS, personnel from the Parks and Recreation Department will install and Donor will provide the flag, along with the related components for the existing flagpole, and there will be no cost to the County, except labor; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by accepting the flag from Donor for the above-stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of its Parks and Recreation Department, to accept a United States flag from Ladies Auxiliary – Veterans of Foreign War, Post 5080, Inc. to be erected by County personnel at the Morrow/Lake City Park. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman and the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution will be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






