RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 09

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, ON BEHALF OF THE AVIATION UNIT OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY APPROVED AND COORDINATED THROUGH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT OFFICE OF EXCESS PROPERTY PROGRAM, GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, FOR A SURPLUS FUEL TRUCK IN FULL OPERATING CONDITION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Aviation Unit of the Clayton County Police Department desires to obtain a surplus military fuel truck now in the possession of DLA Disposition Services in Jacksonville, Florida with requisition number H9DEB112970980; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Public Safety, Law Enforcement Support Office of Excess Property will coordinate this transfer; and

WHEREAS, this surplus military fuel truck will be utilized to store and retrieve fuel and will be housed on the property of the Clayton County Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will be best served by adding an additional fuel truck to the police department fleet.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
