RESOLUTION NO. 2012 – 181

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CORRECTION OF A SCRIVENER’S ERROR IN THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, PART II, CHAPTER 14 “ANIMALS”, ARTICLE VI “RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP LAW”, SECTION 140 “REGISTRATION FOR DANGEROUS OR VICIOUS DOGS”; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners previously adopted Ordinance No. 2012-160, which amended various portions of Chapter 14 “Animals”, Article VI “Responsible Dog Ownership Law”; and

WHEREAS, Section 14-140(e) contained the following scrivener’s error:

“Sec. 14-140. – Registration for dangerous or vicious dogs.

(e) Warning signs of a dangerous or vicious dog shall be posted. In accordance with provisions of O.C.G.A. § 4-8-27, the signs shall be visibly posted for the public to see on all four sides of the premises where the dangerous or vicious dog is kept. The lettering shall be at least six (6) inches in size and in a *contracting* [emphasis added] color to the background.”; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to correct this scrivener’s error as follows:

“(e) Warning signs of a dangerous or vicious dog shall be posted. In accordance with provisions of O.C.G.A. § 4-8-27, the signs shall be visibly posted for the public to see on all four sides of the premises where the dangerous or vicious dog is kept. The lettering shall be at least six (6) inches in size and in a *contrasting* [emphasis added] color to the background.”

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the correction of a scrivener’s error contained in the Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended,


specifically, Part II, Chapter 14 "Animals", Article VI "Responsible Dog Ownership Law",
Section 140 "Registration for Dangerous or Vicious dogs".

Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict
with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.


Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board


