RESOLUTION 2012 – 211

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR OVERSIGHT OF THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE AND AREA 7 ALL HAZARDS COUNCIL SUB-COMMITTEES AND DESIGNATING CLAYTON COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY DIRECTOR AS OVERSEER.

WHEREAS, the metro Atlanta area receives federal funding as recommended by two local councils, the Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) and the Area 7 All Hazards Council (AHC); and

WHEREAS, each Council has sub-committees assigned to particular disciplines or areas of expertise; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no oversight of the sub-committees to ensure continuity of projects, recommendations, funding or share of goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, this policy provides an avenue to ensure participation, collaboration and flow of information to elected officials and department heads through the Emergency Management Agency Director.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby establishes a policy for oversight of the Urban Area Security Initiative and Area 7 All Hazards Council sub-committees and designates the Clayton County Emergency Management Agency Director as overseer.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
