RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 240

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT TWO FORFEITED VEHICLES FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DRUG TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE SALE OF SAID VEHICLES AS SURPLUS ITEMS; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug Task Force seized a 2001 Freightliner Tractor, VIN 1FUJAZAS61LA40701, and a 1996 Mono Trailer, VIN 1NNVA532XTM288038; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicles to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County has forfeited ownership and title of said vehicles to the County under a court order in civil action case number 2012-CV-02675-8; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicles sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by such vehicles.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the said vehicles in accordance with applicable County Ordinances with the proceeds from said auction to be distributed per the Court's orders.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept and auction a 2001 Freightliner Tractor, VIN 1FUJAZAS61LA40701, and a 1996 Mono Trailer, VIN 1NNVA532XTM288038 described in the attached list. The auction shall be conducted in a

manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Clayton County Code Ordinances. The proceeds of the auction of this disposable vehicle shall be distributed as directed in the Court's orders. The Directors of Central Services and Finance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
