RESOLUTION 2012 – 40

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT, ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, TO APPLY FOR JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT THERAPEUTIC SERVICES FOR HIGH-RISK DESIGNATED FELONY OFFENDERS ASSIGNED TO THE SECOND CHANCE COURT PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AND APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Community Health Care of Georgia (“CHCG”) is Clayton County Juvenile Court’s (“Juvenile Court”) current provider of therapeutic services for high-risk designated felony offenders assigned to the Second Chance Court Program; and

WHEREAS, due to financial difficulties, CHCG will be unable to continue these services beyond May 2012; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to continue and further expand these services, Juvenile Court wishes to apply for Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (“JABG”) 2012 funding to provide cognitive behavior therapy, intensive family intervention services, substance abuse treatment and life skills training over a three-year period; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the grant funds will total \$74,920.00 and will require a local match of 10% for which Juvenile Court intends to submit the salary of the Juvenile Court Officer assigned to the Second Chance Court as the required match; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Juvenile Court to apply for Juvenile Accountability Block Grant 2012 funding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS


OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County Juvenile Court to apply for Juvenile Accountability Block Grant 2012 funding in the amount of \$74,920.00 with a local match of 10% for which Juvenile Court intends to submit the salary of the Juvenile Court Officer assigned to the Second Chance Court as the required match. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Grant Application and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


