RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 82

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT WITH CONTAGIOUS BAND PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH LIVE ENTERTAINMENT WILL BE PERFORMED AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Contagious Band (“the Band”) wishes to enter into an Agreement with Clayton County to perform live entertainment at the Clayton County International Park (“the Beach”) during Memorial Day weekend activities, on Saturday, May 26, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Band will begin set-up and sound check at 8:00 a.m. on May 26, 2012 and will perform three (3) sessions between 2:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Band will be paid a fixed rate of \$4,000.00 by Clayton County, Georgia from the account of Clayton County Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the live entertainment will serve as additional entertainment to encourage patrons to choose the Beach as a destination spot on Opening Day and funds are available to support these expenses; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into the Agreement with the Band.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Agreement with Contagious Band (the "Band") to provide live entertainment on Opening Day at the Clayton County International Park ("the Beach") on Saturday, May 26, 2012. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement attached hereto as Attachment "A" and otherwise perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.


