ORDINANCE NO. 2013 – 110

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART II, CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE I “IN GENERAL”, BY REPEALING SECTION 2-9 “PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN CHECKS” AND SUBSTITUTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SECTION 2-9 “PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO SIGN CHECKS”; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**NOW THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED**

Section 1. The CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, Part II, Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article 1 “In General” by deleting Section 2-9 “Persons authorized to sign checks” and substituting in lieu thereof a new Section 2-9 “Persons authorized to sign checks” which shall read as follows:

Sec. 2-9. - Persons authorized to sign checks.

The chairman, or in the absence of the chairman, the vice-chairman, the chief financial officer and such other individuals as the Board of Commissioners may designate by Resolution are authorized to sign checks, drafts or other orders on such accounts, and such depository is authorized to honor such checks, drafts or orders so signed as long as the check, draft or other orders bear the signature of the chairman, vice-chairman or the signature of the chief financial officer. The clerk is authorized and directed to furnish the depository with a certified copy of this section and the specimen signatures of the persons set forth above, together with the depository's usual forms of signature cards, and the depository shall be authorized to rely thereon until written notice to the contrary is received by it.


Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
