RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 119

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO DISPOSE OF 32 ABANDONED FIREARMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH O.C.G.A. § 17-5-52.1; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISBURSAL OF SALE PROCEEDS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department has in its possession 32 firearms which have been determined to be abandoned as defined by law in O.C.G.A. § 17-5-51 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County, in Order Number 2013CV01534-9, has granted authority for the County to dispose of these abandoned firearms in the manner provided for by O.C.G.A. § 17-5-52.1; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the abandoned firearms sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by these firearms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the said firearms in accordance with applicable State Laws with the proceeds from said auction to be paid into the General Fund of the County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to dispose of 32 firearms as described in Exhibit A to Superior Court Order 2013CV01534-9, both of which are attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution. The Director of Central Services shall dispose of the firearms in the manner authorized by O.C.G.A. § 17-5-52.1.

Section 2. The proceeds of the auction of these firearms shall be paid into the General Fund of the County. The Chief of Police and the Director of Central Services are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.


Section 3. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer or the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of this resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
