RESOLUTION NO. 2013 – 122

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF LAW ENFORCEMENT POLICE PACKAGE VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ANY ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OR THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Sheriff's Office wishes to purchase three (3) used law enforcement Crown Victoria police package vehicles from Brannen Ford in Unadilla, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, funds from the Sheriff's Office drug funds will be used to purchase said vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by authorizing the purchase of these vehicles for the stated reasons.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the purchase of three (3) used law enforcement Crown Victoria police package vehicles from Brannen Ford in Unadilla, Georgia for use by the Clayton County Sheriff's Office. Title to the vehicles shall be vested in the County. The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board hereby authorizes

the Chief Financial Officer or the Finance Director to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
