RESOLUTION NO. 2013-279

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT THREE FORFEITED VEHICLES FROM A CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT DRUG INVESTIGATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISBURSAL OF SALE PROCEEDS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department Drug Task Force Division seized a 2003 Toyota Camry (VIN 4T1BE32K73U746139), 1996 Ford F150 (VIN 1FTEF15N4TLA17403), and 1984 Coachman Royal TL (VIN 1TC28561183002832) during a drug investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department Drug Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicles to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Court of Clayton Superior Court has forfeited ownership and title of said vehicle to the County under court orders in case numbers 2012-CV-05561-9 and 2013-CV-02700-8; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the vehicles cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of said vehicles in accordance with

applicable County Ordinance with the proceeds from said auction to be distributed per the Court's orders.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to sell at auction a 2003 Toyota Camry (VIN 4T1BE32K73U746139), 1996 Ford F150 (VIN 1FTEF15N4TLA17403), and a 1984 Coachman Royal TL (VIN 1TC28561183002832). The auction shall be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Section 2-146 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. The proceeds of the auction of such vehicles shall be distributed as directed by a Superior Court orders in case numbers 2013-CV-05561-9 and 2013-CV-02700-8. The Director of Central Services is authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
