RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 29

A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE YEARS OF SERVICE OF POLICE CANINE BOJAR, TO GRANT A CONDITIONAL GIFT FOR HIS REMAINING YEARS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR HIS RETIREMENT FROM ACTIVE SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the County desires to recognize the four years of faithful service of police canine Bojar; and

WHEREAS, the County commends and acknowledges his assistance in the combined seizure of 2000 pounds of marijuana, powder cocaine, methamphetamine, and \$200,000 in cash, with 56 apprehensions; and

WHEREAS, Bojar was first employed as a full service patrol dog in 2009, he is now five and a half years old and developed issues in his handler transfer, where he now has reached the end of his ability to work as a patrol dog; and

WHEREAS Officer Charles S. McDaniel has been Bojar's human partner since 2012 and wishes to provide for Bojar in his retirement and for his remaining years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED:

Section 1. The County formally recognizes and commends Officer Charles S. McDaniel and his canine partner, Bojar, for years of outstanding service to the community.

Section 2. The Chairman is authorized to enter into a contract to provide for a conditional gift of canine Bojar to Charles S. McDaniel. Where Charles S. McDaniel is to have and to hold Bojar for the remainder of Bojar's life, on the condition that Bojar shall not be sold, loaned, given to another, or used as a police canine; and on the further condition that should Charles S. McDaniel be no longer able or willing to provide for Bojar or should there be a default of the stated condition, that Bojar shall be returned to the

County's Animal Control Unit.

Section 3. Police canine Bojar is hereby retired from active service with the Clayton County Police Department.
