RESOLUTION NO. 2014-123

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT WITH SOLID SOUL BAND PHASE II PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH LIVE ENTERTAINMENT WILL BE PERFORMED AT THE J. CHARLEY GRISWELL SENIOR CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County and Solid Soul Band Phase II (the "Band") wish to enter into a Performance Agreement for live entertainment to be performed at the J. Charley Griswell Senior Center during the Center's Senior Prom on Saturday, June 28, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Band will perform one session between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County will pay the Band a fixed rate of \$500.00 for the performance; and

WHEREAS, the Band's live entertainment will serve as a non-traditional form of entertainment to encourage seniors to make the Senior Prom an annual affair; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into an agreement with the Band for the foregoing purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Performance Agreement with Solid Soul Band Phase II to provide live entertainment at the J. Charley Gwiswell Senior Center on Saturday, June 28, 2014.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement attached hereto and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of this resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.

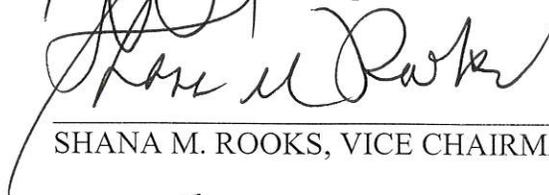
