RESOLUTION NO. 2014-150

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT SEIZED VEHICLES FROM CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT DRUG INVESTIGATIONS; TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISBURSAL OF SALE PROCEEDS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police-Drug Task Force Division seized a blue 2000 Lincoln Town Car, VIN 1LNHM81W0YY837736 and a black 1993 Ford Ranger Truck, VIN 1FTCR10A7PUD25538 during drug investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police-Drug Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicles to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton has forfeited ownership and title of said vehicles to the County under a court order in case numbers 2014-CV-00749-9 and 2013-CV-05315-6; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the vehicles cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by these vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of said vehicles in accordance

with applicable County Ordinances with the proceeds from said auction to be distributed per the Court's orders.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to sell at auction a blue 2000 Lincoln Town Car, VIN 1LNHM81W0YY837736 and a black 1993 Ford Ranger Truck, VIN 1FTCR10A7PUD25538. The auction shall be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Section 2-146 of the Clayton County Code Ordinances. The proceeds of the auction of these vehicles shall be distributed as directed by Superior Court order in case numbers 2014-CV-00749-9 and 2013-CV-05315-6. The Director of Central Services is authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




