RESOLUTION NO. 2014-160

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRADE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF A CONDEMNED VEHICLE FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE-DRUG TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE DISPOSITION OF SAID VEHICLES AS SURPLUS ITEMS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE TRADE OF SUCH PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug Task Force seized a 2009 Maserati Granturismo, VIN ZAMGJ45A790042761, during a drug investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicle to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County has forfeited ownership and title of said vehicle to the County under court order in case number 2014-CV-00174-5; and

WHEREAS, the Terry Cullen Southlake Chevrolet, Inc. has agreed to take this vehicle in trade for three vehicles that are suitable for police use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by authorizing the Director of Central Services

to affect the trade of this vehicle to Terry Cullen Southlake Chevrolet, Inc. (“Terry Cullen”) pursuant to the offers as evidenced attached hereto; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, to accept title to a 2009 Masarati Granturismo, VIN ZAMGJ45A790042761; and to exchange said vehicle to Terry Cullen Southlake Chevrolet, Inc. for three vehicles: 2012 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 2WD, VIN 1GCNCPEX8CZ132340; 2013 Chrysler 200 Touring Sedan 4 Door, VIN 1C3CCBBB6DN728076; and 2013 Chrysler 200 LX Sedan 4 Door, VIN 1C3CCBAG4DN736674. These three vehicles are to be assigned to the Clayton County Police Department’s vehicle fleet for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement in accordance with Clayton County Superior Court order in case number 2014-CV-00174-5. The directors of Central Services and Fleet Maintenance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution. Any remaining proceeds from this vehicle swap shall be deposited in the 221 (city sharing) Drug Account. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required to carry out the intent of this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




