RESOLUTION NO. 2014-171

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE'S FY2014 SCHOOL JUSTICE COLLABORATION PROGRAM TO ADDRESS INTERVENTION METHODS FOR KEEPING YOUTH OUT OF THE COURT SYSTEM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE APPLICATION AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Juvenile Court plans to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice's FY2014 School Justice Collaboration Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding, if awarded, will be used to identify programs and practices to address truancy, graduation rates, school safety planning, crisis/trauma intervention counseling and mental health issues which lead to involvement in the formal Juvenile Justice System; and

WHEREAS, available grant funding is capped at \$600,000 over a 36 month period with no County matching funds required; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept the grant funding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County on behalf of Clayton County Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funding from the U.S.

Department of Justice's FY2014 School Justice Collaboration Program. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Grant Application as well as any related documents, and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
