RESOLUTION NO. 2014-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH PATH FOUNDATION, INC. TO UPDATE THE COUNTYWIDE GREENWAY TRAIL MASTER PLAN IN CLAYTON COUNTY WILL BE ADMINISTERED; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the acceptance of the Project agreement will allow the PATH foundation will combine their years of trail development experience, in conjunction with a local steering committee to be established, to make final preparations for the roll-out and development of Clayton County's greenspace trail; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of the Commissioners has further determined that the introduction of a greenway trail system will promote economic growth, appreciation of property values and tourism in the county; and

WHEREAS, the Project Agreement will have no financial impact on the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into a Project Agreement with PATH Foundation, Inc. for the above-stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Project Agreement with PATH Foundation, Inc. to update the countywide greenway trail master plan. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Agreement and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Agreement shall be in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the Board of Commissioners may approve.






