RESOLUTION NO. 2014-223

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A CHICAGO BATTERY CHARGER, A HUSKY AIR COMPRESSOR WITH HOSE, AND A SALTER BRECKNELL SCALE AS ABANDONED PROPERTY PURSUANT TO OCGA § 17-5-54(a)(1) AND SUPERIOR COURT ORDER 13CV05324-9 FOR OFFICIAL USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT THE PROPERTY ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY, AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Police Department came into the possession of a Chicago battery charger, a Husky air compressor with hose, and a Salter Brecknell scale as property and as this property was unclaimed in excess of ninety days and is considered abandoned property under the law, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to OCGA § 17-5-54(a)(1), the Police Department did petition the Superior Court of Clayton County for an order to allow the Department to retain the above described abandoned property for official use; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court did grant the petition and issued an Order, under Superior Court Case Number 13CV05324-9, that the Department may retain the above described abandoned property for official use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by accepting the above described abandoned property for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept a Chicago battery charger, a Husky air compressor with hose, and a Salter Brecknell scale pursuant to an Order issued by the Superior Court of Clayton County in Case Number 13-CV-05324-9 and in accordance with OCGA § 17-5-54(a)(1). The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute any documents necessary, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. However, this Resolution is neither intended to directly or indirectly authorize the execution of any agreement for any service with any third party unless specifically set forth herein. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
