RESOLUTION NO. 2014-233

A RESOLUTION TO CORRECT CERTAIN ERRORS PERTAINING TO PREVIOUSLY APPROVED INCREASES IN SUPPLEMENTAL COMPENSATION FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners previously approved Resolution No. 2014-202 which authorized increases in the supplemental compensation of certain Clayton County elected officials, employees of the State of Georgia and other persons employed in County offices or performing duties essential to County operations; and

WHEREAS, errors pertaining to the supplemental compensation for Assistant District Attorney Billy Dixon and to a vacant Executive Assistant District Attorney position in the District Attorney's Office were later discovered; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds it necessary to correct those errors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby reduces the supplemental compensation for Assistant District Attorney Billy Dixon from \$16,622.00 to \$5,269.00. The Board also removes any supplemental compensation affixed to a vacant Executive Assistant District Attorney position as this position has been eliminated. All other supplemental increases approved in Resolution No. 2014-202 remain unaffected by this

Resolution. The Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget as necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense.


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
