RESOLUTION NO. 2014-296

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT, ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY, TO APPLY FOR AND IF AWARDED ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS OFFERED BY THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE COORDINATING COUNCIL FOR THE 2014 JUVENILE JUSTICE DELINQUENCY PREVENTION AND TREATMENT PROGRAM TO SERVE YOUTH REQUIRING COURT INTERVENTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Juvenile Court, on behalf of the Clayton County, wishes to apply for grant funds offered by the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for the 2014 Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention and Treatment Program; and

WHEREAS, the Program is targeted to serve youth who are in the initial stages of court action due to juvenile delinquency and requiring formal court intervention;

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be awarded in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 with no County financial match required; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept the grant funding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept grant funds offered by the Criminal Justice Coordinating

Council for the 2014 Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention and Treatment Program to serve youth requiring court intervention. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




