RESOLUTION NO. 2014-307

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITIES OF RIVERDALE AND JONESBORO FOR THE OPERATION OF A JOINT ANTI-DRUG TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the laws of Georgia authorize local governments to conduct joint operations for public safety such as drug enforcement; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County, along with the cities of Riverdale and Jonesboro desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement to operate a Joint Anti-Drug Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by entering into this Intergovernmental Agreement for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS


OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

SO RESOLVED, this the 18 of November, 2014.






