ORDINANCE NO. 2014-314

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE IV, PURCHASES AND PROPERTY DISPOSITION, SECTION 2-147 “DISPOSAL OF UNSERVICEABLE PROPERTY”, SO AS TO ADD A NEW SECTION (c) THERETO RELATING TO DISPOSAL OF PUBLIC SAFETY UNIFORMS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Chapter 2, Administration, Article IV, Purchases and Property Disposition, Section 2-147 “Disposal of Unserviceable Property”, by adding a new section (c) thereto, which relates to the disposal of public safety uniforms and shall read as follows:

“(c)

When any wearable item that identifies a County law enforcement or public safety agency becomes worn out or no longer useful, the Fire Chief, at the request of the purchasing agent, shall dispose of such items in a manner deemed to be in the best interest of the County. Wearable items include but are not limited to, uniforms, patches, and cloth shields.”


Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
