ORDINANCE NO. 2015-143

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART II, CHAPTER 14 “ANIMALS”, ARTICLE VII “RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNERSHIP LAW”, BY REPEALING AND DELETING THE EXISTING SUBSECTION (E) OF SECTION 14-137.1 “ANIMAL CONTROL BOARD” AND SUBSTITUTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SUBSECTION (E) OF SECTION 14-137.1 “ANIMAL CONTROL BOARD”; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part II, Chapter 14 “Animals”, Article VII “Responsible Dog Ownership Law”, by repealing and deleting the existing subsection (e) of Section 14-137.1 “Animal Control Board” and substituting in lieu thereof a new subsection (e) of Section 14-137.1 “Animal Control Board” to read as follows:

“Sec. 14-137.1. – Animal Control Board.

(e) The animal control board shall meet as often as it deems necessary but not fewer than once per quarter. The board shall meet, set its meeting schedule for the upcoming calendar year no later than December 31st of each calendar year, and notify the board of commissioners in writing of said schedule.”

Section 2. Subsections (a), (b) (c) and (d) of Section 14-137.1 “Animal Control Board” are not changed, repealed or amended by this Ordinance, and continue in full force and effect as previously written, adopted and ordained by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 3. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




