RESOLUTION NO. 2015-179

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH VISIONS OUTREACH, INC. PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE FOURTH ANNUAL VET FEST WILL BE HOSTED AT THE CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN to EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Visions Outreach, Inc. (the "Promoter") wishes to utilize the 5K route, Amphitheater/Stadium, Sports Pavilion, and the St. Johns parking lot at Clayton County International Park (the "Location") to host its Fourth Annual Vet Fest, consisting of food, promotional and merchandise vendors, a car and bike show, live musical entertainment, a 5K run, and a health fair; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter wishes to utilize the Location in Jonesboro, Georgia on Sunday, August 30, 2015 from approximately 7:00 A.M. until 6:30 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, no funding is required by the County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department (the "Department") is requesting consideration by the Board of Commissioners to approve the Department's recommended fees for non-profit organizations for the event; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into a License Agreement with the Promoter to host this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into a License Agreement with Visions Outreach, Inc. (the “Promoter”) providing for the hosting of its Fourth Annual Vet Fest, which consists of food, promotional and merchandise vendors; a car and bike show; live musical entertainment; a 5K run; and a health fair, on Sunday, August 30, 2015 from approximately 7:00 A.M. until 6:30 P.M. at the Clayton County International Park. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the License Agreement attached hereto and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. The Board of Commissioners approves the Parks and Recreation Department’s recommended fees as outlined in the License Agreement, to be paid by the Promoter for the event.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners and is contingent upon complete satisfaction of all insurance requirements prior to the initial event date as provided by the Clayton County Risk Management Department.






