ORDINANCE NO. 2015-37

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY, CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, PART II, CHAPTER 62 "OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS", ARTICLE I "GENERAL", BY REPEALING AND DELETING THE EXISTING SUBSECTION (D) OF SECTION 62-7 "LOITERING" AND SUBSTITUTING IN LIEU THEREOF A NEW SUBSECTION (D); TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

**Section 1.** The Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part II, Chapter 62 "Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions", Article I "General", by repealing and deleting the existing subsection (d) of Section 62-7 "Loitering" and substituting in lieu thereof a new subsection (d) to read as follows:

**"Sec. 62-7. - Loitering.**

(d) *Penalty.* Any person violating any provisions of this section shall be punished as provided in Section 1-12 of the County Code."

**Section 2.** Subsections (a), (b) and (c) of Section 62-7 “Loitering” are not changed, repealed or amended by this Ordinance, and continue in full force and effect as previously written, adopted and approved by the Board of Commissioners.

**Section 3.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


