RESOLUTION NO. 2016-143

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT FORFEITED REAL PROPERTY PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 16-13-49 AND SUPERIOR COURT ORDER 2016-CV-04127-9 FOR COUNTY USE WITHOUT RESTRICTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT THE PROPERTY ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY, AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 16-13-49, the Police Department did petition the Superior Court of Clayton County to allow the Department to retain certain forfeited real property more fully described in the exhibit to Superior Court Order 2016-CV-04127-9 and the real property located at 7356 Merlin Way, Riverdale, Georgia, and which exhibit and Order are adopted by reference and incorporated into this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court did grant the petition and issued an Order, under Superior Court Case Number 2016-CV-04127-9, to retain said property for official County use; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by accepting property for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept certain real property which is more fully described in the exhibit to the Superior Court order 2016-CV-04127-9. The order and the exhibit are hereby adopted by reference and incorporated into this Resolution. Said property, which is forfeited pursuant to OCGA § 16-13-49, has been granted to the County for use without restriction by the Superior Court of Clayton County. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman, or his designee, to execute any documents necessary, and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
