

2012 Jekyll Island SCHOLARSHIP Application

The Clayton County Parks and Recreation Department will choose 12 students based on the top essays submitted for an opportunity to attend a chaperoned three day, all expenses paid trip to explore Jekyll Island, Georgia. The trip will take place this summer, 2012 and will focus primarily on exploring the outdoors.

All essays, in 250 words or less, should include one of the following ten activities outlined by the Georgia Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights. Students should write on the activity that they wish to experience the most and explain why they have chosen that activity.

- Discover Georgia's Past
- Splash in the water
- Play on a team
- Play in a safe place
- Camp under the stars
- Follow a trail
- Explore nature
- Learn to swim
- Catch a fish
- Celebrate their heritage

Scholarship contestants must reside in Clayton County, Georgia, be 14 years old or younger and currently enrolled in the 7th or 8th grade. Each applicant will be required to write an essay (250 words or less) describing the outdoor activity they wish to participate in. Applicants must include one of the ten activities listed below to write their essay, as well as this completed scholarship application form.
