The Clayton County Department of Transportation and Development is updating its **Comprehensive Transportation Plan** (CTP). The CTP Update will serve as a framework for how Clayton County will improve its transportation networks to serve current and future needs. The plan considers the complete transportation network in Clayton County: roadways and bridges, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, freight facilities and movement, and access to transit. It also considers impacts from the world's busiest airport, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

The County is fully dedicated to ensuring that all segments of the County's population are engaged. This project's strategies for public outreach are focused on gathering input from all sectors of the population.

An **online survey** is now available! The survey allows people who live and work in the County to begin providing feedback to the CTP Update and help set the vision for Clayton County.
